

RESOLUTION # 2009-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC EXPRESSING IT'S SUPPORT OF THE EFFORTS BEING MADE TO RESOLVE THE OWNERSHIP AND TITLE ISSUES AND DISPUTES AND TO REVISE THE NIP AND TUCK ADDITION PROPERTY TRACT LOCATED WITHIN THE REPUBLIC CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, There are a number of conflicting, confusing and outdated claims to ownership in the area of the City known as the Nip and Tuck Addition; and,

WHEREAS, A number of interested parties desires to resolve ownership issues in the area now known as the Nip and Tuck Addition; and,

WHEREAS, The City Council has been made aware of the efforts by the County, the PUD, the EMS District and local landowners to take steps to revise and amend the current Nip and Tuck Addition; and,

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Republic has determined that resolving those issues and cooperating in this project is in the public interest; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council does hereby express its support for the current efforts being made to amend and revise the Nip and Tuck Addition.
2. The City of Republic desires that adequate steps be taken to preserve the City's water and sewer service and easements in the amended or revised Nip and Tuck Addition area.
3. The City of Republic will do whatever it can to facilitate the resolution of the Nip and Tuck Addition ownership, title and access issues.
